Case Study - improving air quality in Victoria


The Built Environment

- Improving the pedestrian experience through:
 - Creating clearer pedestrian routes and connections off the main streets
 - Better pedestrian crossings
 - o Improved wayfinding to neighbouring areas
- Promoting walking and specifically low emission routes reduces vehicle use and personal exposure
- Promoting improved conditions for cyclists through:
 - Dedicated crossings at busy junctions
 - More direct routes to common destinations
- Travel by bicycle around Victoria and through London should be championed as the benefits to health and local air quality are unparalleled
- Creating a greener Victoria:
 - Tree planting
 - Green roofs and walls
- Encouraging biodiversity is key to both uplifting an area and improving health and wellbeing
- Assessing the impact of the gyratory:
 - Countering the dominance of the gyratory and inner ring road
 - Recommending the removal of one way streets
- Any reduction of congestion and improvements to the flow of traffic improve local air quality
